**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$550,400.00 TO RAMOS CONSTRUCTION FOR THE PURCHASE AND CONSTRUCTION OF FENCING AND GATES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND OVERFLOW PARKING LOT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH RAMOS CONSTRUCTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the worked with Pawelek & Moy Civil Engineering ("P & M") for the design and engineering for security fencing to be located around the Seguin Police Department and overflow parking lot to include vehicular and pedestrian gates; and

**WHEREAS**, the City issued a Request for Proposals for the fencing with an alternate bid for an additional pedestrian gate for police to access the city trail system; and

**WHEREAS**, five bids were received ranging from a low bid of \$550,400.00 from the Ramos Construction to a high bid of \$733,244.00 from AllPro Gen Construction; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff along with their consultant P & M reviewed the bid and based on references, experience with similar projects and recommends awarding the bid in an amount not to exceed \$550,400.00 to The Ramos Group.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The bid for the Police Department and Overflow Parking Lot fencing in the amount of \$550,400.00 is awarded to Ramos Construction.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into a construction contract for \$550,400.00 with Ramos Construction for the Police Department Fencing Project.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
