**Subject:** Resolution of the City Council for the City of Seguin, Texas, authorizing submission of a grant application in response to the Texas Department of Transportation's 2025 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TA) call for projects for the King Street (FM 466) Safety Improvements.

**Historical Background**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has posted a grant opportunity entitled 2025 Transportation Alternatives. If awarded, this funding will improve Community-Based Infrastructure, namely sidewalk improvements to improve safety, access, and mobility in the areas of the Guadalupe Regional Medical Center, other medical, nursing and rehabilitation facilities, and commercial areas along Highway 123 Bypass. The sidewalk improvements in this area will enable safe passage to medical facilities and commercial areas. The City has the full support of the Guadalupe Regional Medical Facility and the local community to improve pedestrian access with this project.

**Action Requested**

This is a request to submit a Preliminary Application, with the intent of submitting a Final Application when notified by TxDOT.

**Procurement Methodology & Funding Source**

There are no fiscal impacts to submitting this preliminary application. Future funding needs will be identified during the final application stage.
