Planning and Zoning Commission Report Amendments to the City of Seguin Unified Development Code (UDC) Section 3.5.3.S – Food Truck Parks and Definitions

Pamela Centeno presented the amendments to the Unified Development Code Section 3.4.3 Land Use Matrix Food Trucks, Section 3.5 Limited Use Permit Food Trucks and Definitions. She stated that City Council recommended the proposed amendments to the Food Truck Ordinance at the June 4, 2019 Council Meeting. She explained that the term Mobile Food Vendors is being proposed that will include trailers along with food trucks. Staff also proposed to amend the definition of Mobile Food Vendor Parks to define a location with three or more mobile food vendors. Staff recommended approval of the amendments.

The regular meeting was then recessed, and a public hearing was held. There being no responses from the public the regular meeting reconvened.

After consideration of the staff report and all information given regarding the Unified Development Code Amendments, Commissioner DePalermo moved that the Planning and Zoning Commission recommend approval. Commissioner Kirchner seconded the motion. The following vote was recorded:
