RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT GENERAL VICTIM ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM, FY2025

WHEREAS, the City maintains programs to assist victims of crimes, including the provision of emergency temporary housing; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office has announced a General Victim Assistance Grant for FY2023 to provide funding to assist crime victims: and

WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application entitled <u>FY25 Seguin Crime Victim</u> <u>Assistance</u> with a funding request not to exceed \$25,000 with a 20% matching requirement in response to this grant solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has previously authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application entitled <u>FY25 Seguin Crime Victim Assistance</u> to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division.

SECTION 2: The City Council reaffirms, directs, and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant and to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

SECTION 3: Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Criminal Justice Division guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will ensure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Office of the Governor Public Safety Office.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
