A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FIVE PHYSIO-CONTROL LIFE PACK 15 CARDIAC MONITOR/DEFIBRILLATORS FOR USE BY THE SEGUIN FIRE DEPARTMENT EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO PROTECT THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE CITY'S RESIDENTS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the older Physio-Control cardiac monitor/defibrillators used by the Fire Department's Emergency Medical Services (the "Department") are approaching the end of their life expectancy and need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, in providing the emergency services necessary to protect the city's residents the Department must maintain training and competency in the use of all equipment used by the Department; and

WHEREAS, equipping all vehicles with the same equipment, familiar to all of the Department's emergency staff assists in keeping a constancy in training that provides greater competency and therefore better protection for the City's residents; and

WHEREAS, two years ago the Department purchased four of the Life Pack 15 monitors and now the Company is making it worthwhile to replace the Department's remaining older Life Pack units; and

WHEREAS Physio-Control is offering 0% interest 5 year finance option to cover the \$ 170,885.55 cost of the four Physio-Control Life Pack 15 monitor/defibrillators with the first payment of \$34,140.11 due October 21, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The purchase of five Physio-Control Life Pack 15 Cardiac Monitor/Defibrillators for the sum of \$170,885.55 needed to protect the health and safety of Seguin residents is hereby approved.

Part 2. The 0% financing plan offered by Physio-Control is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this financed purchase.

Part 2. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
