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## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID TO ASSOCIATED CONSTRUCTION PARTNERS, LTD FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WEST BOOSTER STATION, WATER PLANT HIGH SERVICE PUMP, AND CONNECTIONS TO THE HWY. 123 ELEVATED STORAGE TANK PROJECT TO INCLUDE COMPLETE PROJECT STARTUP; AUTOHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ASSOCIATED CONSTRUCTION PARTNERS LTD; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council previously approved an agreement between the City and Springs Hill Water Supply Corporation (WSC) to transfer approximately 9477 acres of CCN area from Springs Hill WSC to Seguin; and

WHEREAS, the above referenced project is critical for the City to serve water to customers in this transfer area; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids for the construction of the West Booster Station, Water Plant High Service Pump, and connections to the Hwy. 123 Elevated Storage Tank to include complete project startup; and

WHEREAS, three bids were received ranging from a low bid of \$17,969,000.00 to a high bid of \$28,442,000.00; and

WHEREAS, reference checks on projects supplied by the bidding contractors found that Associated Construction Partners LTD has completed projects to the satisfaction of the Owners and Engineers.

WHEREAS, based on the reference checks, City staff recommends accepting the low bid of \$17,969,000.00 submitted by Associated Construction Partners LTD; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves the bid submitted by Associated Construction Partners LTD, in the amount of \$17,969,000.00 for the construction of the West Booster Station, Water Plant High Service Pump, and connections to the Hwy. 123 Elevated Storage Tank to include complete project startup.

Part 2. The city manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Associated Construction Partners LTD, for the construction of the West Booster Station, Water Plant High Service Pump, and connections to the Hwy. 123 Elevated Storage Tank to include complete project startup.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
