Re: American Rescue Plan Recovery Act

As you are aware, the City of Seguin was awarded \$7,431,596.18 through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) that allowed local governments funding that would help them address economic recovery and covid relief. During the FY 2021-22 budget process, city staff identified several projects in its capital outlay requests that could be funded by the American Rescue Act. We also knew that this would be a great source of funds to implement some of the City's Parks Master Plan, which was adopted in FY2020, for which a funding source has not been identified.

The City has spent \$955,394 of the \$7,431,596,18 which leaves \$6,476,202.18 in available funds. The City has developed a list of projects that would like the City Council to consider which amount to \$2,829,416. These projects are listed below:
