**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS IN RESPONSE TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY FY2026 RESOLUTION SB 224 CATALYTIC CONVERTER GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement taskforces and agencies for economic motor vehicle theft, including catalytic converter theft; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat catalytic converter theft; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, City of Seguin agrees and assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** and ordered that the City Manager is designed as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Seguin Police Chief Jason Brady is designated as the Program Director and Grants Administrator Kate McCloud is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,**

1. The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority, SB 244 Catalytic Converter Grant Program.
2. The City of Seguin directs and designates Steve Parker, City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and City's participation in the Grant Program.
3. Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the SB 244 Catalytic Converter Grant Program guidelines, terms and condition of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will ensure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority, SB 244 Catalytic Converter Grant Program.
4. This Amended and Restated Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
