Subject: 36-inch Geronimo Creek Wastewater Interceptor

Date: May 7, 2024

At the request of the City, Kimley-Horn prepared a professional engineering services proposal for the design, bidding, and construction phase services to replace and upsize existing 16-inch and 18-inch wastewater main to a 36-inch wastewater main along the Geronimo Creek. This project will increase the capacity in the system for projected peak flows. The project shall include the following components:

1. Approximately 9,000 linear feet of 36-inch PVC wastewater main.
2. Replacement of existing manholes as necessary.
3. Connection to existing manholes upstream and downstream that receive flow from the existing Geronimo Creek interceptor.

Staff recommends acceptance of this professional services proposal in the amount of \$947,000.00. Funding is provided through certificates of obligation. I will be available at the May 7th Council meeting and will be happy to address any questions or concerns.
