**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY THAT IS
OBSOLETE, DYSFUNCTIONAL OR TOO COSTLY TO REPAIR; AND
DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE;**

WHEREAS, from time to time various items of property owned by the City become obsolete, dysfunctional or in need costly repairs that render the item unusable; and

WHEREAS, City policy dictates that the City Council approve the sale of items with a cost of \$5,000.00 or more; and

WHEREAS, approximately five thousand three hundred, TWACS electric meters are obsolete and are no longer useable by the City; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that these items be sold by auction to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council hereby declares that approximately five thousand three hundred, TWACS electric meters are obsolete and are no longer useable by the City.

Part 2. City staff is directed to list the items for sale at auction to be sold to the highest bidder.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
