RE: Amendments to Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances- Food Service Establishments

The City of Seguin currently enforces the Texas Department of State Health Services' (DSHS) rules and regulations for food establishments within the city limits of Seguin. Sec. 22-26 of the Code of Ordinances adopts the State's regulations by reference to ensure that updates to the State's codes are adopted automatically. City staff has recently attended training providing by DSHS on the most recent updates to the State's regulations. The regulations were previously located in Title 25, Chapter 29 of the Texas Administrative Code (TAC). The regulations have been moved to Chapter 28. Staff has drafted an ordinance to update the city's Code of Ordinances to reflect the current location of the State's regulations. The amendments to the ordinance also include the correction to the State Department's name and the locations where the State codes can be located. No other amendments to the Code are proposed.
