Final Engineering Services

At the request of the City of Seguin, TRC Engineers, Inc. prepared a professional engineering service proposal for final engineering related to a groundwater / surface water interconnect water pipeline project of approximately 15,500 linear feet extending from the Hwy. 123 elevated storage tank routing south along Hwy. 123 to Strempe Road turning west, then south and crossing beneath I-10 and connecting to existing water mains on 8th Street and on Guadalupe Street near Rio Nogales St. The scope of work includes both engineering design and construction administration as follows:

- Permitting
- Construction Documents
- Bidding Support
- Construction Support
- Construction Inspection

The construction is budgeted for FY23. Services will be provided in accordance with the Master Service Agreement (dated December 16, 2003) executed by the City and TRC. The funding source is 2023 Utility Revenue Bonds. Staff recommends acceptance of this engineering proposal in the amount of \$1,054,400.00 and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, November 15, 2022 City Council Meeting.
