Subject: Request for Annexation by Property Owner located at 7817 IH 10

East; Approximately 17.72 acres (Prop ID: 174278)


The City of Seguin was notified in June 2020 of the subdividing and selling of a 106.773 acre tract with an active development agreement. Per TLGC Sec 212.172, a development agreement was offered to and accepted by the former property owners in 2012. The development agreement was recorded in the Real Property Records of Guadalupe County on February 25, 2013. The owners subdivided the tract into six lots in 2019 and sold them off individually. City Staff contacted the six new property owners to offer development agreements under their names. All but one accepted and signed new agreements.

This annexation request is for the property in which the new owner didn't sign a new agreement. In addition to being subdivided, the property has also been developed and is being used for non-residential purposes. Section 3 of the original 2013 development agreement states the following – "The Owner acknowledges that if any plat or related development document is filed in violation of this Agreement, or if the Owner commences development of the Property in violation of this Agreement, then in addition to the City's other remedies, such act will constitute a petition for voluntary annexation by the Owner, and the Property will be subject to annexation at the discretion of the City Council." The development agreement runs with the Property and a notice of ownership change to the City was required prior to sale.

In June 2020, staff sent letters to the new property owners. The property owner of 7817 IH 10 East called staff to ask questions about the development agreement and requested more time to review the agreement. Staff sent notices to the property owner two more times with no response before starting the annexation process.

Staff recommends approval of the request for annexation into the city limits of Seguin. Attached please find a copy of the Ordinance with exhibits identifying the area to be annexed as well as a copy of the original development agreement.
