STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS RESCINDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 2016R-53, PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON OR ABOUT APRIL 2, 2016; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2016 the City of Seguin joined other local entities to oppose an application for a landfill permit filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality by Post Oak Clean Green, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, after the permit was granted, the City of Seguin and other local entities appealed via petition (D-1-GN-8-007000) in the 201st Judicial District Court of Travis County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, while that permit application and appeal were pending, the City of Seguin also adopted and made effective Resolution Number 2016R-53, which called for any contract for Solid Waste Disposal involving the City of Seguin to include terms forbidding disposal of solid waste in the Post Oak Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Post Oak Landfill has now been operating for many years, and has now opened a Citizens Convenience Center, open to the general public, for disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the parties to the appeal of TCEQ's permit, including the City of Seguin, the City of Schertz, the Schertz-Seguin Local Government Corporation, and the Guadalupe County Groundwater Conservation District (D-1-GN-8-007000), recently Non-Suited the appeal, effectively ending their objection to the permit under which Post Oak Clean Green, Inc. operates; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin recognizes that, while Resolution Number 2016R-53 was appropriate at the time of its adoption, ongoing prohibitions against the use of the Post Oak Landfill by solid waste carriers only serve to increase costs to the citizens utilizing those services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas, that:

- 1. Resolution Number 2016R-53 of the City Council of Seguin, Texas is hereby rescinded; and
- 2. This Resolution shall be Effective the date of its passage by the City Council.
