Subject: **Resolution releasing properties from the City's ETJ as requested by Violet Pennington, for Property ID No.'s 65677, 66024 and 122240**

Date: September 9, 2024

Senate Bill 2038, passed during the 2023 legislative session, provides procedures for a landowner to seek release from a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) by filing a Petition with the City. The petition must meet certain requirements to qualify for release.

The City of Seguin has received a request from Violet Pennington to release a total of 319.336-acres of land that she owns from the City's ETJ. Staff has verified that the request meets the requirements of the State statute. Violet Pennington is the sole owner of the properties. Per the new statute, the City of Seguin must release the properties from the ETJ.
