Historical Background

On November 4, 2025, Council approved the second amendment for engineering services related to the extension of the 12-inch water main and an additional 3,800 linear footage (LF) of 8-inch water main. The Utilities Department in conjunction with Capital Projects & Engineering requested additional engineering services for the extension of a 12-inch wastewater main along SH-123 and the Esher Property (PID 54937) in anticipation for Rudeloff Rd Phase 2.

Action Requested

Consider a resolution authorizing an amendment for an extension of approximately 750 LF of 12-inch wastewater main, to include encasement of existing water main under future Rudeloff Rd, and all necessary appurtenances.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

WGA provided the City’s Utilities Department with an amendment proposal in the amount of \$94,053.00 for an extension of approximately 750 LF of 12-inch wastewater main, to include encasement of existing water main under future Rudeloff Rd, and all necessary appurtenances.

Funding for this project has been secured through certificates of obligation.

Staff Recommendation

It is recommended the amendment be approved in the amount of \$94,053.00.
