**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GUADALUPE REGIONAL
MEDICAL CENTER, GUADALUPE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SEGUIN
FOR THE PROVISION OF INDIGENT HEALTHCARE**

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe Regional Medical Center (“GRMC”) follows the Texas Department of State Health Services Indigent Health Care Program; and

WHEREAS, each year the City of Seguin, Guadalupe County, and GRMC enter into an Interlocal Agreement for Indigent Healthcare that includes an obligation for the City to share in the cost of indigent healthcare; and

WHEREAS, this year’s Interlocal Agreement sets the City’s cost share at \$2,560,519.00; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2023, the City will pay to the County one-half of its share in the amount of \$1,280,259.50; and

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2024, rather than being issued a rebate, GRMC will provide a statement of indigent costs to date, for which the City will pay 50% of any balance greater than \$100.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

PART ONE. The attached Interlocal Agreement between the City of Seguin, Guadalupe County and the Guadalupe Regional Medical Center is approved.

PART TWO. The City Manager Steve Parker is authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement for Indigent Health Care.

PART THREE. This Resolution is retroactively effective September 1, 2023.
