A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$150,000.00 TO SHARE WITH NEW BRAUNFELS FOR BUILLDING IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CENTRAL TEXAS TECHNOLOGY CENTER

WHEREAS, since its inception the City of Seguin and the City of New Braunfels have shared financial responsibilities for the building and operation of the Central Texas Technology Center ("CTTC"); and

WHEREAS, the CTTC provides valuable education and skill training for Seguin residents, and others, in order to prepare them for jobs with local manufacturers; and

WHEREAS, better training not only assists local manufacturers and businesses but also provides worker skills that can lead to better salaries; and

WHERAS, the continuing operation of CTTC is a benefit to the citizens of Seguin; and

WHEREAS, the HVAC system in one of the buildings housing sensitive machinery is failing and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the repair and replacement is \$410,000.00, with Seguin providing \$150,000.00 and New Braunfels \$235,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Seguin Economic Development Corporation has agreed to provide one half of the Seguin share.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council hereby approves the expenditure of up an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 for building improvements at the Central Texas Technology Center.

Part 2. To reach that amount the City Council approves spending \$75,000.00 along with the \$75,000.00 approved by the Seguin Economic Development Corporation.

Part 2. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
