**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN TEXAS APPROVING A LOCAL HISTORICAL MARKER AT HOME LOCATED AT 113 EAST LIVE OAK STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the home located at 113 East Live Oak Street was built in 1929 by Arthur and Violet Vivroux; and

**WHEREAS**, Arthur and Violet Vivroux were the owners of Vivroux Hardware and both served as treasurer for the City of Seguin; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1979 the home was purchased by the Zies family who have been active in the Conservation Society, a small business owner and a journalism teacher at the high school; and

**WHEREAS**, the original shape, size and scale of the home is intact but the wood siding has been replaced with vinyl; and

**WHEREAS**, recognizing and preserving historical structures has been a long standing program for the City of Seguin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Seguin Conservation Society, the Historic Design Review Committee and the Guadalupe County Historical Commission have all approved of the placement of a local historical marker at the East Live Oak Street home; and

**WHEREAS**, with the affirmative votes of the above groups the home meets the requirements for the placement of a local historical marker.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

**SECTION ONE.** The City Council hereby approves of the placement of a local historical marker at the home located at 113 East Live Oak Street.
