A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DANNENBAUM ENGINEERING COMPANY – AUSTIN, LLC, FOR A FEMA FLOODPLAIN STUDY AND SUBMISSION OF A LETTER OF MAP REVISION FOR MAYS CREEK FROM STATE HIGHWAY 46 TO THE GUADALUPE RIVER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in order to speed up the development process the City has been performing flood plain analysis on some of the unstudied floodplain areas; and

WHEREAS, Mays Creek is one of the unstudied FEMA flood zone A areas where future residential development may occur; and

WHEREAS, Dannenbaum Engineering – Austin, LLC ("Dannenbaum") performed a floodplain analysis on part of Little Mill Creek and Mill Creek and is familiar with the area; and

WHEREAS, the attached professional services agreement proposed by Dannenbaum, in the sum of \$61,342.00, will cover the floodplain study and the submission of a Letter of Map Revision to FEMA for the studied area; and

WHEREAS, City staff is also proposing a development fee to recoup some of the costs from the future developers who will benefit from this study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$61,342.00 submitted by Dannenbaum for a floodplain study and submission of a LOMR for Mays Creek.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional services agreement with Dannenbaum.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
