## **153.125 ACRE TRACT**

S 29° 27' 25" E, 613.53 feet (called N 28° 17' 49" W, 613.74 feet in Volume 2632 at Page 378) to a 1/2 inch diameter rebar found with cap (BLS) marking a re-entrant corner of the tract herein described, same being a re-entrant corner of said 231.73 acre tract and southwest corner of said 21.000 acre tract, and

N 89° 19′ 51″ E, 500.04 feet (called N 89° 27′ 00″ W, 500.00 feet in Volume 2632 at Page 378) to a 1/2 inch diameter rebar found with cap (BLS) marking the east most northeast corner of the tract herein described, same being the east most northeast corner of said residue 231.73 acre tract, southeast corner of said 21,000 acre tract, lying in the west line of Huber Road (aka County Road 105).
