A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION'S SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION HIGH DEMAND JOB TRAINING PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE SEDC EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE GRANT APPLICATION MANAGEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Seguin Economic Development Corporation (the "SEDC") has the opportunity to submit a grant application for the Texas Workforce Commission's High Demand Job Training Program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the High Demand Job Training Program is to establish collaborations between local Workforce Development Boards and local economic development corporations to provide training for high demand industrial jobs; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC proposes a grant submittal to help offset the purchase of equipment necessary TX-FAME – Lone Star Chapter to fill a skills training gap existing in the South-Central Texas region so that students will be able to receive an associates degree in Applied Science in Advanced Manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, if awarded the SEDC will provide \$150,000.00 in leveraged funding to work with Workforce Solutions Alamo to provide the advanced manufacturing training; and

WHEREAS, on October 31, 2022, by Resolution 2022-20, the SEDC Board of Directors approved filing a grant application to the Texas Workforce Commission's High Demand Training Grant Program along with approving the needed \$150,000 in leveraged funds and directing that the SEDC Executive Director serve as the grant administrator authorized to execute all documents necessary for the grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1. The Seguin City Council hereby ratifies the action of the SEDC Board of Directors and approves the filing of an application to the Texas Workforce Commission's High Demand Training Grant Program.

PART 2. The Seguin City Council further approves the expenditure of \$150,000.00 required as leveraged funds should the High Demand Training Grant be approved.

Part 3. The SEDC Executive Director, Joshua Schneuker, is authorized to execute the grant application and to serve as the SEDC's authorized representative for all documents related to the High Demand Training Grant Program.

PART 4. This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after its passage.
