Progressive Waste Solutions is proposing a route change to the solid waste service. The proposal would be to mirror the recycle route currently in place with a few exceptions. Progressive plans to dedicate two (2) solid waste trucks and one (1) recycle truck to each route. Progressive feels that the plan would eliminate confusion of which day is regular garbage or which day is recycle, eliminate the number of missed pick-ups, and at the same time reduce the number of man-hours.

Progressive will coordinate with city staff to prepare the flyers and maps to be posted on each container for at least two weeks prior to the effective date, as well as prepare door hangers as reminders of the change. They will also work with city staff to prepare press releases and post to the city's website notifying citizens of the change. The route change will be effective Monday, May 4, 2015.

Jim Hare, District Municipal Marketing Manager, and Mike Flores, Operations Manager, with Progressive Waste Solutions will be at the City Council meeting for the presentation and to answer any questions.
