RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT PROGRAM FOR FY2023

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin Police Department is desiring equipment to enhance protection of law enforcement officers by acquiring new rifle-resistant body armor; and

WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application entitled <u>FY23 Rifle-Resistant Armor</u> not to exceed \$75,000 with no required matching funds in response to this grant solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has previously authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application entitled <u>FY23 Rifle-Resistant Armor</u> to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division.

SECTION 2: The City Council reaffirms, directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application, including the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3: Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Criminal Justice Division guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Office of the Governor Public Safety Office.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
