Dr. Northeim's medical career began in the field of EMS at age fifteen dispatching and eventually working on a paramedic 911 ambulance for Life Care Ambulance Service in Cleveland, OH. He completed an externship with Metro Life Flight, Cleveland, OH. He attended Bucknell University and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Biology/Spanish. BEST EMS now serves as the Medical Control entity for twenty-two agencies in Texas.
