A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FILED BY CATHERINE MEDLIN FOR ONE PARCEL OF LAND WITH PROPERTY ID 28834 ALONG GUADALUPE STREET, AND GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, during the 2023 session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2038 wherein a landowner could petition a municipality for release of their property from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Catherine Medlin filed a Petition for release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction for one parcel of land with Property ID 28834, totaling approximately 0.29 acres located at 610 Guadalupe Street, Kingsbury, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Catherine Medlin has presented the City with a Petition for Release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction that meets the requisites of the Statute; and

WHEREAS, the Petition submitted by Catherine Medlin meets the requisites of the new law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

- **PART 1.** The Petition for release of one parcel of land owned by Catherine Medlin is accepted.
- **PART 2.** The parcel of land being Block 19, Lot 5, Kingsbury Addition, Property ID 28834; and as more particularly described in the attached block map, is hereby released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Seguin.
- **PART 3.** City staff is hereby directed to amend the official maps of the City of Seguin to reflect the above release of land from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- **PART 4.** This Resolution is in full force and effect beginning October 3, 2023.
