A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FUQUAY, INC. FOR THE COUNTRY CLUB DRIVE UTILITY REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO INCLUDE VARIOUS APPURTENANCES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH FUQUAY, INC.; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Utilities Department evaluated the condition of the wastewater infrastructure along Country Club Drive to determine if replacement is necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended based on the number of maintenance work orders associated with the existing sewer main and its close proximity to mature trees, which has made the line susceptible to root intrusion; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements include replacing the existing six-inch (6") sewer main with a new eight-inch (8") sewer main; and

WHEREAS, a proposal was obtained from Fuquay, Inc. to pipe burst a new 8" wastewater mains based on contract prices from the purchasing cooperative known as BuyBoard; and

WHEREAS, BuyBoard is a national purchasing cooperative administered by the State of Texas and purchases utilizing BuyBoard contracts comply with Texas bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends accepting the proposal of \$497,605.20 submitted by Fuquay, Inc. plus \$52,394.80 in contingency for a total amount of \$550,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves the proposal submitted by Fuquay, Inc. in the amount of \$497,605.20 for the installation of the new 8" wastewater mains of the Country Club Drive Utility Replacement Project to include various appurtenances, plus \$52,394.80 in contingency for a total amount of \$550,000.00.

Part 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Fuquay, Inc., for the for the installation of the new 8" wastewater mains of the Country Club Drive Utility Replacement Project to include various appurtenances.

Part 3. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
