## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TERMINATION OF THE MUNICIPAL PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN AND COFFEE TECH INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A NEW HEADQUARTERS AND MANUFACTURING FACILITY IN SEGUIN, TEXAS

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2020, the City Council, along with the Seguin Economic Development Corporation and Guadalupe County, approved economic incentives, including a Municipal Property Tax Abatement Agreement with Coffee Tech Industries, Inc. ("CTI"); and

**WHEREAS,** in return for specified economic development incentives, CTI was to build a 112,000 square foot state of the art manufacturing facility and corporate headquarters on a 33-acre site situated between 8th and Guadalupe Streets south of IH-10; and

WHEREAS, according to the agreements CTI was to commence construction on or before December 31, 2020, which was extended to June 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, operations were to commence on or before the extended date of December 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the agreement to extend the dates the City, the SEDC and Guadalupe County added a default clause that stated in the event that construction did not commence on or before June 1, 2021, the entities reserved the right to terminate their respective agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, CTI has informed city staff that they were unable to secure funding and they were terminating their project for an indefinite time.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

- **Part 1.** The City Council hereby finds the Coffee Tech Industries has not met the obligations set forth in the Municipal Tax Abatement Agreement.
- **Part 2.** Through the default provisions in the Municipal Tax Abatement Agreement the City Council hereby exercises its right of termination.
- **Part 3.** The Municipal Tax Abatement Agreement between the City of Seguin and Coffee Tech Industries is hereby terminated effective on the day this Resolution passed.
