Subject: Resolution to submit application for the FY2026 Bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles Grant Program

Historical Background

The Office of the Governor (OOG), Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division is currently accepting applications for the FY2026 Bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles Grant Program. The purpose of this program is to equip motor vehicles used by peace officers with certain bullet-resistant components.

City staff would like to submit an application to this program for 40 bullet resistant windshields, 116 bullet resistant windows, and 116 Kevlar door panels for Seguin Police Department vehicles. The estimated cost for this project is \$508,000, there are no matching funds required for this grant. Grant awards are expected to be announced in February of 2026. If the City is awarded this grant, the project will begin in March.

Action Requested

City Council must approve the resolution to authorize the submission of this grant application.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

If the grant is awarded, 100% of the funding will be secured through the grant.

Procurements will be made according to the City of Seguin Purchasing Policy
