**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
CORPORATION'S EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING WITH THE ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT,
INC. D/B/A WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS ALAMO, RELATING TO THE
APPLICATION FOR A TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION HIGH DEMAND
JOB TRAINING GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Seguin Economic Development Corporation (the "SEDC") is a public instrumentality and non-profit industrial development corporation duly established and operating under Texas Local Government Code, Chapters 50 I and 504, *et seq.*, as amended, known as the Development Corporation Act of 1979 (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, Workforce Solutions Alamo (WSA) serves as the governing board for the 13- county Alamo region workforce system, with the mission of strengthening the regional economy by growing and connecting talent pipelines to employers; and

WHEREAS, WSA and the SEDC will cooperate to establish a mutually beneficial relationship supporting a Texas Workforce Commission's (TWC) High Demand Job Training (HDJT) grant, through collaboration, reporting, and funding; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC has reviewed the terms, conditions and obligations related to a Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU"), has considered, and evaluated the benefits of the MOU, and has determined it to be in the best interest of the SEDC to enter into the MOU.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city Council of the City of Seguin, Texas that:

SECTION 1. The recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if restated in full.

SECTION 2. The SEDC and the Director of Economic Development are authorized to take all necessary actions and to execute an MOU with the WSA in substantially the same form as reflected in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage and approval.
