

STATE OF TEXAS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, REPEALING DIVISION 5, SECTIONS 2-111 THROUGH 2-116 OF THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, DISSOLVING THE SEGUIN CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU BOARD, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Division 5 of the Seguin Code of Ordinances, Sections 2-111 through 2-116, establishes the Seguin Convention and Visitors Bureau Board (“CVB Board”) and outlines its duties, composition, and meeting requirements; and

WHEREAS, the CVB Board has not convened or performed its advisory functions since 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the duties of the CVB Board can be effectively performed by City staff in coordination with the City Manager’s Office, thereby eliminating the need for a separate advisory body; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to streamline operations and remove inactive boards from the Code of Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Repeal of Division 5. Division 5 of the Seguin Code of Ordinances, Sections 2-111 through 2-116, entitled “Seguin Convention and Visitors Bureau Board,” is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Dissolution of the CVB Board. The Seguin Convention and Visitors Bureau Board is hereby dissolved, and all references to the CVB Board in City policies, manuals, or other governing documents shall be updated accordingly.

SECTION 3. Transfer of Duties. All duties and responsibilities previously assigned to the CVB Board shall be carried out by the Seguin Convention and Visitors Bureau Director, under the supervision of the City Manager, and with direction from the City Council.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective and applicable on the date of its approval and passage.
