A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE REALIGNMENT OF THE CONNECT SEGUIN BUS ROUTE; RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2015R-19; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2015, the City Council passed Resolution 2015R-19 establishing a realignment of the Connect Seguin Bus Route operated by the Alamo Council of Governments ("AACOG"); and

WHEREAS, in order to improve ridership AACOG analyzed the number of persons using each of the current stops; and

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2015 a public hearing was held so that AACOG, along with City staff, could present potential stops for elimination and solicit public input on the location of potential replacement stops; and

WHEREAS, based on analysis and public input it has been determined that the route included second stops at four locations: ZDT, Health Center, MHMR and Downtown; and

WHEREAS, these four stops are underutilized with a total ridership of about 6.3%; and

WHEREAS, AACOG recommends removing these four stops from the route and replacing them with two new stops: (1) one at the corner of Braden and Heideke; and (2) the Teatro de Artes area at Hidalgo and Allende.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1: Resolution 2015R-19 adopted by the Council on February 17, 2015, that established a new realignment of the fixed bus route is rescinded.

PART 2. The recommendation outlined above and shown on the attached new route for the Connect Seguin bus system is hereby approved.

PART 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
