Subject: Award of Bid – Huber Road 24” Sanitary Sewer Project

Date: July 30, 2018

On July 10, 2018, the City of Seguin opened bids for the Huber Road 24” Sanitary Sewer Project. The project will consist of the installation of approximately 6,700 linear feet of 24 inch sanitary sewer gravity main along Huber Road extending from the existing 24 inch sewer main on the north side of IH-10 to the north side of Rudeloff Road.

Fifteen sealed bids were received for the project, which ranged from \$1,281,389.75 from M&C Fonseca Construction of Granite Shoals, Texas, to \$2,171,646.08 from E-Z Bel Construction of San Antonio, Texas. Beau Perry, P.E., Vice President with TRC and city staff have reviewed the proposed bids and recommend awarding the contract to M&C Fonseca Construction based on strong references, experience with similar projects, and being the lowest qualified bidder. Funding source for project is 2018 Utility Revenue Bonds.

Please find attached Bid Recommendation Letter from TRC dated July 31, 2018 recommending that M&C Fonseca Construction be awarded the construction project in the amount of \$1,281,389.75. Staff concurs with this recommendation and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, August 7, 2018 City Council Meeting.
