A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AFFILIATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AND TEXAS LUTHERAN UNIVERSITY TO ALLOW THE SEGUIN EMS TO SERVE AS A CLINICAL TRAINING SITE FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN NURSING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, in order to serve as a clinical training site for students who are enrolled in appropriate emergency medical technician, paramedic or nursing programs the Seguin Fire Department must enter into an affiliation agreement with each of the several universities, community colleges or other entities that desire to participate; and

WHEREAS, clinical training is an essential part of the training protocol for emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, Texas Lutheran University has requested that the Seguin Fire Department enter into an affiliation agreement wherein senior nursing students can have the opportunity to hone their skills in emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, Texas Lutheran University will provide insurance and training necessary for this endeavor; and

WHEREAS, participating in clinical training programs is, in the long run, beneficial to the City's emergency medical service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

Part One: The attached Affiliation Agreement with Texas Lutheran University is approved and the City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to execute the Affiliation Agreement.

Part Two: This Resolution is in full force and effect on and from the date of its approval.
