Subject: **Comprehensive Safety Action Plan Safe Streets and Roads For All (SS4A) Resolution**

Date: September 3, 2024

The City of Seguin was recently awarded the Safe Streets and Roads For All (SS4A) Grant through the US Department of Transportation. The SS4A Action Plan is being developed to provide a framework of innovative strategies and implementation actions intended to reduce transportation-related fatalities and serious injuries while supporting federal safety initiatives. The City desires standards and policies to ensure that all users are accommodated in a safe and equitable manner on our roadways.

The SS4A Study Review Committee is composed of agencies, organizations, and stakeholders from the Seguin Area. The Study Review Committee has met four times to date. A draft Comprehensive Safety Action Plan is anticipated to be completed at the end of July.

This resolution is specifically to adopt the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan Vision Statement of **“Striving for a safer community, Seguin is dedicated to developing an equitable transportation network that prioritizes safety, preserves all lives, and maintains the existing community character. As regional leaders, our mission is to**
