Subject: Public Hearing and First Reading of an Ordinance of the City Council of Seguin, Texas amending the Seguin Code of Ordinances Chapter 98, Section 98-40, No Through Truck Traffic, to restrict truck traffic on Hiddenbrooke Pass; authorizing City Staff to prepare this Ordinance as a supplement to the City Code of Ordinances; and declaring an effective date.

Historical Background

Current City ordinance designates “no through truck traffic” streets as streets with a restriction on through commercial vehicles with two or more rear axles unless they are making a delivery to an address on that street. Due to construction traffic, an increase in commercial vehicles have been observed on Hiddenbrooke Pass. There are many homes fronting both streets and the primary land uses are residential.

Action Requested

Due to the limited existing right-of-way and surrounding residential land uses, staff is recommending a through truck restriction on Hiddenbrooke Pass. The Hiddenbrooke Homeowners Association have requested a through truck restriction on Hiddenbrooke Pass.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

No Through Truck signage costs \$200 for Hiddenbrooke Pass and is funded through the Public Works Street Maintenance Budget.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommend approval of restrictions to truck traffic as proposed.
