A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, APPROVING UPDATES TO THE CITY'S PURCHASING POLICY TO INCORPORATE THRESHOLD INCREASES AND CLARIFICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH BILL 1173.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin maintains a Purchasing Policy that governs the procurement of goods and services to ensure compliance with state law and fiscal responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas enacted Bill 1173, effective September 1, 2025, which amended certain purchasing thresholds and requirements applicable to local agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed its current Purchasing Policy and determined that updates are needed to align with the new statutory thresholds and provide additional clarity in procurement procedures; and

WHEREAS, the updated policy increases thresholds for informal and formal procurements, clarifies procedural guidelines, and promotes efficient purchasing practices while maintaining accountability and competitiveness;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby approves the updated City Purchasing Policy as presented by staff and attached to this resolution as **Exhibit A**.
- 2. The City Manager, or their designee, is authorized to implement the revised policy and make administrative changes as needed to ensure ongoing compliance with state and federal law.
- 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
