

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDED A BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,831,407.60 TO AUSTIN FILTER SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE NOLAN STREET OUTFALL EMERGENCY REPAIR PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH AUSTIN FILTER SYSTEMS, INC.; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the July 5, 2025 storm event caused severe erosion and outfall degradation at the Nolan Street outfall to the Guadalupe River; and

WHEREAS, design of the outfall emergency repair was complete by Pape-Dawson Engineers who is listed on the City's IDIQ contract list in the stormwater category; and

WHEREAS, in response to the City's request the City received two sealed bids for the Nolan Street Outfall Emergency Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, the qualified bids ranged from a low base bid of \$1,664,916.00 submitted by Austin Filter Systems, Inc. to a high of \$2,697,379.00 submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC; and

WHEREAS, after considering the bids, performing an extensive reference check by Pape-Dawson Engineers and evaluation bid amount per unit price, the City recommends awarding the contract to the lowest bidder Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for the bid price of \$1,664,916.00, plus \$166,491.60 in contingency for a total amount of \$1,831,407.60.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby awards the contract in the amount of \$1,831,407.60 to Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for the Nolan Street Outfall Emergency Repair Project.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute a construction contract with Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for the Nolan Street Outfall Emergency Repair Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
