Historical Background

The City of Seguin has utilized SEnergy Engineering for the past ten years for Electrical support, including but not limited to financial services, costs of service studies, rate recommendations, power supply planning, regulatory services and compliance, and electric distribution system planning. This year, the City of Seguin requested a proposal for a system fusing study. A systemfusing study will provide necessary information facilitated by the exponential growth throughout the city. The study will also assist in keeping the system updated and help keep our employees safe while working on the high-voltage lines. Be advised that throughout our tenure with SEnergy Engineering, they have provided the City of Seguin with exceptional services.

The Purchasing Department and Legal Counsel have advised that Schneider Engineering should be placed under a Master Services Agreement, supported by a resolution finding Schneider to be an appropriate professional service provider for utilities-related projects based on its demonstrated competence and qualifications. That is the basis for the Master Services Agreement.

Action Requested

Execution of the Master Services Agreement will support the following known projects, as well as additional as-needed projects:

Regulatory Services/ Agency Tracking and Compliance Support -\$18,000

General Energy Services Support-\$10,000

Financial Services - \$35,000

Electric System planning - \$14,000

Power Planning Support - \$35,000

System Fusing Study – \$36,000
