**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS  
ADOPTING THE JOINT BASE SAN ANTONIO-RANDOLPH  
JOINT LAND USE STUDY (JBASA-RANDOLPH JLUS) TO ASSIST THE CITY OF  
SEGUIN IN GUIDING PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES THAT  
IMPACT THE AREAS SURROUNDING THE SEGUIN AUXILIARY AIRFIELD**

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin participated in the development of the JBASA-Randolph JLUS through its membership on the Executive Committee and Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Seguin Auxiliary Airfield supports training activities of Randolph Air Force Base, which is an important key to protecting our Nation's security; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the JBASA-Randolph JLUS is to protect the viability of current and future military training operations, while simultaneously guiding community growth, sustaining the environmental and economic health of the region, and protecting public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City played a role in the development of the JBASA-Randolph JLUS and the City's input provided technical guidance relevant to the City's policies, regulations, culture and values; and

WHEREAS, the JBASA-Randolph JLUS strategies incorporate a variety of actions that can be implemented to promote compatible land use and resource planning; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the strategies may require public input and engagement, input from City boards and commissions, and further action by City Council through the adoption of local ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

That the Seguin City Council adopts the JBASA-Randolph Joint Land Use Study and directs City Staff to develop processes to evaluate and implement the strategies applicable to the City of Seguin as appropriate.
