CITY OF SEGUIN

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SEGUIN CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE LAWFUL SPEED LIMIT AT 40 MILES PER HOUR ON RUDELOFF ROAD FROM FM 78 TO RIDGE CREST DRIVE; AND ESTABLISHING THE LAWFUL SPEED LIMIT AT 30 MILES PER HOUR ON RIVER OAK DRIVE FROM FM 725 TO THE NORTH END OF RIVER OAK DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, an engineering and traffic investigation has been made to determine the maximum, reasonable and prudent speed on both Rudeloff Road and River Oak Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned investigation has determined that on Rudeloff Road from FM 78 to Ridge Crest Drive the maximum, reasonable and prudent speed should be 40 miles per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned investigation has determined that on River Oak Drive from FM 725 to the north end of River Oak Drive the maximum, reasonable and prudent speed should be 30 miles per hour.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The speed limit on Rudeloff Road from FM 78 to Ridge Crest Drive, in both directions, shall be reduced to 40 miles per hour.

**SECTION 2.** The speed limit on River Oak Drive from FM 725 to the north end of River Oak Drive, in both directions, shall be reduced to 30 miles per hour.

**SECTION 3.** The City's Public Works Director is hereby authorized to install signage in accordance with this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.

**SECTION 5.** If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

**SECTION 6.** In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
