A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH MERRICK & COMPANY FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO THE CITY’S SURFACE WATER TRANSMISSION SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City entered into a water sales agreement with New Braunfels Utilities (“NBU”) that will involve the construction of an interconnect between the City’s surface water system and a new line being constructed by NBU; and

WHEREAS, although NBU is paying for the interconnect, it is in Seguin’s best interest to select a site that will maximize any obtainable collateral benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed professional services agreement with Merrick and Company develop a new water distribution model for surface water; and

WHEREAS, the professional service agreement will also include the evaluation of existing water demands, analysis of those demands, and model future demand in order to incorporate those analyses in any improvements to the surface water distribution program; and

WHEREAS, Merrick and Company was hired by NBU to provide similar services with respect to the interconnect; therefore Seguin’s use of the same company will avoid the cost of duplicated work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement, in the amount of \$62,489.70 with Merrick & Company to perform a surface water distribution study to maximize the efficiency of the system and the proposed interconnect with New Braunfels Utility.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement Merrick & Company for the services outlined in the attached proposal.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
