amount of \$1,280,000.00 for the Prexy Drive Utility Replacement Project; and declaring an

effective date.

Historical Background

Prexy Drive is scheduled for improvements. The Utilities Department evaluated the condition of the water and wastewater infrastructure and determined the need to replace this infrastructure. It is prudent to do so before street improvements commence. Proposed improvements include replacing two-inch (2"), three-inch (3"), and six-inch (6") water mains as well as 6-inch (6") sewer mains with 8" water and sewer mains.

Action Requested

Consider a resolution authorizing the proposal to install approximately 3,000 linear feet (LF) of 8-inch water main and approximately 1,200 linear feet of 6-inch sewer main and other appurtenances.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

A proposal was obtained from Fuquay, Inc. to install a new 8" water main, pipe burst the existing sewer main, and other appurtenances based on contract prices from the purchasing cooperative known as BuyBoard. The total proposal amount is \$1,167,609.00

Funding for this project has been secured through certificates of obligation.

Staff Recommendation

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It is recommended that Fuquay, Inc. be awarded this proposal for \$1,167,609.00, plus \$112,391.00 in contingencies, for a total not to exceed \$1,280,000.00. Purchases using BuyBoard contracts comply with Texas Bidding requirements and Fuquay has completed similar projects to the satisfaction of the City.
