AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 UTILITY FUND BUDGET OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS; DECLARING THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY REQUIRING ONLY ONE READING; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 UTILITY FUND BUDGET OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Reason requested:	To appropriate funds for expenditures related to recovery efforts from the flooding on July 5, 2025, pursuant to Mayor Donna Dodgen’s Local Disaster Declaration issued on July 5, 2025.	

The Council finds that these budget adjustments are required because of changes and unforeseen conditions that could not have been anticipated in the original budget. The importance of this Ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the provisions of the Charter requiring that ordinances be presented at two separate meetings, and that ordinances do not take effect until ten days after the date of final passage are suspended, and this Ordinance will be effective and applicable on the date of its approval and passage.
