A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SEGUIN
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR
THE DOWNTOWN SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO SUPPORT
EXPANDED BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY OF SEGUIN

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has initiated a sidewalk improvement project which is designed to replace ADA non-compliant sidewalks within the downtown area on South Austin and West Nolte Streets and to fill in the sidewalk gaps on E. Court Street between San Marcos and King Street (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin will be putting over \$70,000 into the Project and has asked the SEDC for assistance with the remainder of the costs; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC has previously set aside funds dedicated to downtown infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors finds that financially contributing to the Project will support new and expanded business development in the City of Seguin;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Seguin Economic Development Corporation that the SEDC will fund up to \$50,000.00 of the downtown sidewalk improvement project in conjunction with funds from the City of Seguin.
