Subject: Seguin Brewing Farmer's – Artisan Market

Date: April 11, 2018

Seguin Brewing has requested permission to close the 100-block of West Gonzales Street, in front of Seguin Brewing the second Saturday of each month for a Farmer's – Artisan's Market. The hours of operation will be 11:00 am – 4:00 pm, with set up to begin at 9:00 am and clean up by 5:00 pm.

The following are the dates of the monthly street closures: May 12; June 9; July 14; August 11; September 8; October 13; November 10; December 8, 2018; January 12; February 9; March 9; and April 13, 2019.

Seguin Brewing will comply as required with city requirements along with the annual general liability insurance.

Staff also notified the neighboring businesses on the block about the proposed street closures. The only comment received came from First United Bank and they supported the market as long as their customers would be able to still use the drive thru, which they will be able to. Most of the neighboring businesses are not open on Saturdays, so weekend street closures should have a minimal impact on their business.

Staff recommends approval of this request for the monthly street closure.
