RE: Downtown Sidewalk Improvement Project Expenditure

The Sidewalk Improvement Project is designed to replace non-compliant sidewalks within the downtown area on South Austin and West Nolte Streets and fill on the sidewalk “gaps” on East Court Street between San Marcos Street and King Street.

Funding for the project will come from the FY 2016 General Fund Budget in the amount of \$40,630, which was designated for the project after engineering, and \$30,000 that had previously been designated for bus stop pads (this project has been placed on hold pending better ridership information from AACOG). In addition, the SEDC is funding \$50,000 towards the project from its Downtown Infrastructure budget fund. SEDC Staff believes that this project will help to support expanded business development within the downtown area.

Attached you will find a funding resolution for \$50,000.00 for the Seguin Economic Development Corporation’s portion of funding for the Sidewalk Improvement Project. The Seguin Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors approved the expenditure at their January 11, 2016 Board Meeting. Since the expenditure is \$50,000, City Council must approve the expenditure before it can be processed.
