**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AWARDING A BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$168,763.65 TO FUQUAY, INC. FOR
THE 2018 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH FUQUAY,
INC.; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, as part of the budgetary process City Council approved funding for street maintenance using a chip seal process; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids for two separate maintenance applications and on March 27, 2018, resulting in receiving four qualified bids; and

WHEREAS, the qualified bids ranged from a low of \$168,763.65 submitted by Fuquay, Inc. to a high of \$269,043.50 submitted by Clark Construction of Texas, Inc; and

WHEREAS, the low bidder, Fuquay, Inc., has successfully performed projects for the City over the last two years therefore staff recommends awarding the bid to them.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. Fuquay, Inc., as low bidder, is awarded the bid in the amount of \$168,763.65 for the 2018 Pavement Maintenance Project.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to enter into a construction contract with Fuquay, Inc. for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
