

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SEGUIN
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL
FUNDING FOR THE MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGY ACADEMY AND THE
INFORMATION AND TECHNOLOGY SECURITY ACADEMY THROUGH THE
CENTRAL TEXAS TECHNOLOGY CENTER

WHEREAS, the Central Texas Technology Center ("CTTC") is a project that the SEDC has supported with critical funding since its inception, and which has provided valuable education and job training in the local area; and

WHEREAS, the CTTC has developed the Manufacturing Technology Academy and the Information and Technology Security Academy as a way to assist high school students with obtaining job training and college credits to prepare them for entering the workforce; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC has previously given assistance for funding textbook and testing costs so that Seguin ISD and Navarro ISD students may take advantage of these valuable programs who might otherwise not be able to afford them; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC has received an additional request to assist with the costs of testing; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC Board finds that the additional assistance will support the goals of having a well-trained and work-ready local workforce which will in turn attract new businesses to the Seguin area;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Seguin Economic Development Corporation that financial assistance in the amount of \$71,000.00 is hereby authorized to be given to pay for costs associated with testing for Seguin ISD and Navarro ISD's participation in the CTTC's Manufacturing Technology Academy and Information and Technology Security Academy.
