STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR TRUANCY PREVENTION; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, as part of the changes made to the juvenile truancy laws a "juvenile truancy prevention fee" was added to court cases filed in certain Texas Courts; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has determined that enough truancy prevention funds exist to begin a grant program; and

WHEREAS, Seguin Youth Services desires to apply, through the City of Seguin, for a Truancy Prevention Grant to provide services for younger at risk children; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required for this grant; and

WHEREAS, if awarded Seguin Youth Services will enter into an Agreement with the City regarding the use of the funds and their continuing obligation to the City should any challenges to said use arise; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds awarded, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Douglas G. Faseler, City Manager, to apply to the Governor's Office Division of Criminal Justice for a grant from the truancy prevention program.

Part 2. The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler is hereby designated as the City's executive officer and official representative for the application and administration of the grant.
